



## The Top 25 "Best Value" Burgundy 2017s

- Contrary to popular opinion, there is **still great value in Burgundy**, even from famous producers from Premier and Grand Cru vineyards. But you have to know where to look!
- We screened 200 of the current **Burgundy 2017** wines to find the "Top 25" highest score / lowest price wines. We were surprised to find so many undervalued wines still available. But these won't stay on the market for much longer, and once sold they will be **very difficult to find again** at primary market prices.
- All of these wines scored at least **93 points** from a leading Burgundy Critic (*Burghound*, *Wine Advocate*, *Vinous* or *Decanter*).
- The wines towards the top of the list are the most undervalued.

## The "Top 25 Best Value" Burgundy 2017 Wines - Methodology

We screened almost 200 Burgundy 2017 wines and selected those with: 93 points or better from either: *Burghound (BH)*, *Wine Advocate (WA)*, *Vinous (VN)* or *Decanter (DC)* (including score ranges) and a decent drinking window (at least 5 years).

We then sorted them by the cost per critic point per 75cl bottle to normalise the score/price ratio for easy comparison.

### How to Read the Table

From the table, we see that **Faiveley Mercurey 1er Cru Clos du Roy 2017 (6x75cl)** is the best value Burgundy 2017 currently available on Cru with a price per point of only HK\$2.21:

The HK\$2.21 is calculated as follows:

$$75\text{cl bottle price} = \text{HK\$}205.83 / 93 \text{ points} = \text{HK\$}2.21 \text{ per point per bottle}$$

### Who is the Cru Top 25 Best Value Burgundy 2017 Wines List for?

#### Drinkers:

For drinkers these wines (theoretically) represent the best value currently available in Burgundy 2017. They combine the highest respected critic score with the lowest price – with enough drinking window left to ensure that you can enjoy them over a number of years.

#### Collectors / Investors:

For investors, these wines are should offer good investment potential, because they are all significantly undervalued by the market today. We would advise investors to buy up wines towards the top of the list to benefit from their reversion up to fair value.

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
